Lady Paramount: Lady Katrina Vanstone. Judge for the Western Round: Sir Peter Conisbee.

A charge of £6.00 will be levied on those who wish to compete and they should assemble on the field of battle at 10 of the clock.

For the shooting of the Western round, the rules of that ancient body Archery GB will be strictly observed. The afternoon battle will be shot according to the rules laid down by the Kings Herald and will be scrupulously adhered to.

Refreshments will be available as cakes and a slab of porcine between slices of bread, with tea and coffee - sorry no ale.

DIRECTIONS: For those of you with Satium Navigum - Notre Dame School, Looseleigh Lane, Plymouth, Devon PL6 5HN. For those still in the Dark Ages - If entering the City from East or West – use the City Ring Road (Parkway) and exit North on A386 signposted Tavistock. Then travel under the flyover, exit first left at the Roundabout signposted Tamerton Foliot into Looseleigh Lane, Dame Close (entrance to school 400 yards on right Notre Dame will be marked).

If approaching from North to Plymouth on A386 exit right into Looseleigh Lane at Derriford Roundabout (ignore signs for "Airport", "College & "Hospital") then enter the School as above.
