Trophies will be awarded as follows: York and Hereford rounds – 1st Gents and Ladies trophies, 2nd/3rd Gents and Ladies medals; Bristol and National rounds – trophies and medals according to age groups and entry.

Assembly PM - 2pm (sighters at 2.15pm) - National, New & Long National, Junior National

Rules: All rounds to be shot according to Archery GB rules.
Dress code 307 must be complied with.

Venue: Notre Dame RC School, Looseleigh Lane, Plymouth, Devon PL6 5HN.

Car Parking: Please park in the designated areas/parking bays. Under no circumstances is anyone allowed to park on the roundabout at the school's Reception.

Food: Light refreshments will be available during the day.
